Hello again Pack 22 families! Here are some more details on our **Night at the Museum Fall Camping Trip, Saturday, Nov 2nd!** The boys will get a chance to take part in interactive educational activities, have access to a special exhibit, get a flashlight tour of the fossil halls, and also get to see a film in the Museum's IMAX Theater. A light snack is served Saturday night, with breakfast Sunday morning. The cost is \$125 per person, but because the boys did such a great job fundraising last year, the Pack is picking up \$25, bringing costs down to \$100 per person. I have included the Museum's information as well as links to FAQs, check in details, and release forms below. NOTE: We need to provide final payment by Saturday October 5th! After that, we can add folks, but we can't subtract! Also, the Museum offers a discounted parking fee for its garage (see below) but there may be alternative parking options and/or you should explore carpooling opportunities. PLEASE! Handle all registration, release forms, etc. with the Pack, and not with the Museum. CHECK-IN

Check-in begins at 5:45 p.m. and ends promptly at 8:00 p.m. Please enter through the Rose Center for Earth and Space at 81st Street between Central Park West and Columbus Avenue or through the Museum's parking garage adjacent to this entrance. Our staff members will direct you to the check-in desk and guide you to your sleeping location, where you will store your belongings for the night.

PARTICIPANT PERMISSION AND RELEASE FORMS

Each participant must submit participant permission and release forms and must include the child's age. The program is for children ages 6-13, (scout 6-16). The completed forms are due on the night of the event when you check in.

PARKING

Parking is available at our facility conveniently located within the Museum. The garage is located on 81st Street between Central Park West and Columbus Avenue and will open to sleepover participants at 4:00 p.m. for a discounted parking fee of \$28.00 for the duration of the sleepover. Please request your parking passes at check-in on the day of your event. Visitors taking advantage of this discount must leave by 1:00 p.m. For travel alternatives as well as directions to the Museum, please call [212-769-5100](tel:212-769-5100).

ORIENTATION

Orientation will take place at 6:30 p.m. in the Milstein Hall of Ocean Life, where a brief presentation will provide guidelines and information about the sleepover program.

FOOD

An evening snack and a light breakfast will be provided. Please note that the Museum does not provide dinner during the sleepover program, so we suggest that you eat before you arrive. **The Museum's Food Court Café will also be open from 5:30-7:30 p.m.**, and vending machines in the Lower Level will be available. Please remember to bring change for the vending machines. There will be no food or drinks permitted in the exhibition halls and sleeping locations. The American Museum of Natural History no longer sells bottled water at the vending machines for environmental reasons. You are welcome to bring your own bottled water to A Night at the Museum sleepover.

MEMORABILIA

A Night at the Museum T-shirts (\$15.00) and patches (\$5.00) will be on sale for souvenirs exclusively through the sleepover program from 7:30-9:30 p.m. only. These items are not available in the Museum Main shop.
